CV of Kalyankumar Bandyopadhyay

Born in Krishnangar City of West Bengal, India in 1947, Kalyankumar Bandyopadhyay did his schooling in Ramakrishna Mission Schools. He received BE, ME and PhD degrees in Electronics and Telecommunications Engineering from Jadavpur University, Kolkata.
